Covenant Worship

If you are visiting us for the first time, we are so glad to have you! Having children in the service may be new to some of you.

Here is a brief explanation of why we encourage the children to be present and to participate in the worship service.

- 1) We find a biblical pattern of the inclusion of ALL God's people (*including children*) in the covenant assemblies of worship.

 (Josh. 8:35 | Joel 2:15-16 | Eph. 6:1)
- 2) God's covenant of grace was made with both believers and their children. (Gen. 17:7-8 | Acts 2:39) There is a multi-generational dimension to our faith that we seek to reflect in our worship and ministry.
- 3) Parents have been entrusted with the primary responsibility of transmitting the faith to their children (Deut. 6:5-9 | Eph. 6:4). Worshipping together provides a wonderful opportunity to disciple our children in the all-important activity of worship.
- 4) Regarding the children, Jesus said, "The kingdom of God belongs to such as these." (Mk. 10:14). The presence of children gloriously reflects the kingdom of God and *enhances* our worship.

Covenant Worship is simply **one** of five ways we disciple our children at LFPC. In a partnership with parents, we seek to raise our children in the faith by:

- 1. Establishing Godly Heads of Household
- 2. Nurturing Gospel-Centered Marriages
- 3. Encouraging Parental Discipleship
- 4. Worshipping as Families (i.e. Covenant Worship)
- 5. Children's/Youth Ministry | Sunday School
